- 3 You will be able to customise your gift list page, add a personal welcome message along with photographs of yourselves and where you are going for all your guests to see when they access your page. You can also share you gift list via Facebook and Twitter.
- 4 Your guests can access your gift list, view your pictures, leave you a message and a contribution to your honeymoon.
- 5 Once the balance for your honeymoon is due, you will be able to use all your contributions towards paying it off. Any money that is contributed after this time we will refund so you can use the money to enjoy your honeymoon and married life together!
- 6 **TOP TIP** - Increase your contributions by using the social media icons to share your gift list to facebook and twitter so your friends can see it and contribute!

How To Use Our Honeymoon Gift List

Setting Up Your Gift List

Once you have booked your honeymoon and paid the associated deposit, we will set you up with a gift list. At this point you can send us any pictures you want added to your gift list page along with a welcome/thank you message to all your contributors. Upon your request we can also send out gift list cards to direct guests to your gift list page which you may want to insert into your wedding invitations. Sharing your page on Facebook and Twitter using the social media icons is a great way to increase your contributions as all your friends and followers will be able to see it.

Making a Contribution

Visit www.honeymoondreams.co.uk/gift-list where you will find our gift list page. Wedding guests wanting to make a contribution to your gift list must then enter your booking reference number (will begin with "hmd") into the box on our gift list page. In order to contribute they must then click on the yellow button which will take the guest to the secure Paypal payment area where they can enter their details and make a contribution. Alternatively you may contribute over the phone by calling 0121 440 6268 or by sending us a cheque. Once a payment has been confirmed, you will get an automatic email with details to inform you that somebody has made a contribution and it will update your total. There is a 3.5% Paypal transaction handling fee, per payment, which is deducted from each contribution towards your gift list. To make a card payment by phone please call us. There is no fee for debit card however a 2% charge applies to credit cards.

Viewing Your Contributions

On our gift page (www.honeymoondreams.co.uk/gift-list) under the Client Login box on the right-hand side of the screen enter your booking reference followed by the password which we will supply you with when you set up your gift list (If you forget or would like to reset your password, simply call us on 0121 440 6268). You will then be able to see all of the payments to your gift list and the amount that has been paid.

Closing Your Gift List

The remaining balance of your honeymoon, after your deposit and any other payments made, must be received twelve weeks prior to departure. We will use the entire gift list amount that you have received by that date towards the balance. If you still continue to receive contributions after this final payment date, we will then arrange a refund for extra payments so you can use the money to enjoy your honeymoon or towards a happily married life! We would suggest not closing your gift list until after your wedding as many guests tend to leave it until the last minute to contribute.
